

German Saturday School

The Saturday school of **Deutsche Schule Kobe/European School** is a Saturday morning school open to children with a German speaking background. This course is designed to meet the demand from parents for a German program structured to the specific needs of children who desire to master the German language or to enhance their German language skills.

We offer classes to children from pre-school to Grade 9. The school year consists of 30 weeks with 2 terms. Lessons are conducted by our native German teachers based on the curriculum designed according to the students' year level and competency. In addition to our educational program, we hope to provide an opportunity not only to the children but also to the parents to become a part of the foreign community by joining our Saturday School.

Eligibility to join our Saturday School

All children applying for the German Saturday School program at Deutsche Schule Kobe/ European School must have a sufficient German ability for their age level to join the program.

A trial day is required before acceptance into the program.

5 years old ~ 16 years old by September 1st, 2017

4~10 students in each class.

Lessons

Lessons will be conducted by our qualified native German teachers covering reading, writing, listening and speaking. We will include many games and activities to make the lessons more interactive and stimulating for students.

Fees

Trial day fee: ¥5,000 (Only for the prospective students)

Registration fee: ¥15,000 (Only for the first year, non- refundable. This includes the school bag)

Tuition fee: ¥135,000 a year (Lump sum payment only)

Notebook fee: ¥500

Sibling Discount

Families with 2 or more children in the Saturday program are eligible for a sibling discount.

2nd child 12% discount for the 2nd child

3rd child 15 % discount for the 3rd child

4th child 20 % discount for the 4th child

Enrollment

Application Procedure:

- 1- Complete the online application form
- 2- The coordinator will contact you via email to set up a trial date
- 3- The student has the trial day in class. The coordinator and teacher will meet with parents to discuss the trial after classes.
- 4- The coordinator will consult with the teacher and contact the family via email with the decision of acceptance.
- 5- If successful, the student can start classes as soon as possible. The school office will contact the family with payment information.

Returning students:

- o All fees and registration information must be paid by **June 1st, 2017**.

New Students:

- o Registration fee, tuition and textbook fees must be paid more than 5 days before the child starts classes.

**Withdrawal**

Tuition fee is not refundable in any case.

Saturday School report

Your child will receive a school report of their progress at the end of each term from their class teacher.
